### C.M.A. TOURNAMENT 2012

Dear C.M.A. Students and Parents/Guardians,

This year's C.M.A. National Tournament will be held on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> of June at the Allan Brewster Stadium in Papatoetoe, Auckland.

For those of you not familiar with our National Tournament it is our marquee event for the year and a great day for both competitors and spectators alike. The tournament runs from preliminary bouts in the morning through to the final rounds and presentation of medals in the afternoon. The tournament is an elimination event with competitors of similar age and size put into one of four divisions facing off against each other in a controlled safe environment with referees, coaches, judges and full protective equipment. It is a great opportunity for students of all ages and skill levels to test their skill against another competitor and compete for places in their respective Divisions.

The main goals of the tournament are to build confidence levels of the students, overcome fear, promote self defence and most importantly have fun whilst gaining an understanding of the effectiveness of their techniques through competition. The Tournament is conducted in a safe controlled environment and I would encourage all students no matter what your level to enter.

#### Tournament Workshop

Students will be learning about tournament techniques during the term as well as going through the rules for tournament (tournament rules can be found in the student zone website). In addition to this we will be running a series of workshops on the weekends throughout May and June. The initial workshop will act as an introduction to tournament for those students (and parents) new to tournament that might be nervous about participating, we will go through the reasons we do tournament, the basis rules, putting on protective the equipment and basic blocking and kicking techniques. Following workshops will focus more on preparing students for tournament, working on different aspects such as combinations, movement, and tactics finetuning students towards tournament.

#### Tournament Entry

The Tournament Entry Fee is \$65, an application form is included with this letter, and additional copies can be downloaded from the C.M.A. Website at <http://www.cmamartialarts.org/tournament.html>. This year's Tournament will be restricted to the first 128 entrants so please return the form and fee to your Club Instructor or to C.M.A. Headquarters (postal address above) ASAP, **applications close on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> June.**

Entry into the venue for spectators is by ticket only, tickets can now be purchased from your C.M.A. Instructor for the cost \$5 each, families can purchase a family concession of 5 tickets for \$20. Tickets are sold as a fundraiser and each ticket is also entered into a raffle prize draw for a number of prizes provided by our generous sponsors. Each contestant receives free entry into the venue, a contestant pack and an additional entry ticket. The Allen Brewster management freely allows food and drinks to be brought into the venue and seats are set up alongside two rings so I encourage you to bring the family, bring a chilly bin and stay for a few hours to watch the bouts.

June is a very busy time of year with Saturday winter sports in full swing; the National Tournament is only once per year so I would strongly recommend that students who have Saturday sports commitments to give their teams notice now so they can keep this Saturday free.

## Tournament Fundraising and Sponsorship

The National Tournament is our marquee event for the year and takes a considerable amount of time, effort and expense to organise. It is not run for profit so our fundraising and the support of sponsors are key to making it all possible.

Thank you for all of you who supported us by purchasing chocolates and C.M.A. Socks. 4 packs of socks are still available for \$20 as well as Official Grading Photos from Term 1 Grading for \$12 and can be purchased from myself or C.M.A. HQ. We will also be running a number of sausage sizzles in May and June so keep a look out for these.

Sponsorship may range from providing a small item for the contestant pack, or larger items which can be raffled to raise funds for new training equipment or that can be given as prizes to division winners. If you or/your business are able to assist with sponsoring the event or if you have contacts who might be willing to help please let me know as this will go a long way to ensuring a successful event. Alternatively if you are able to promote the event through the media or assist in the selling of tickets this would also be greatly appreciated.
